Mentor Form

We are actively seeking teachers, water professionals and others active in their community's water issues to serve as mentors to the students selected to participate in the Arizona Rivers' Riparian Research Experience (RRE). Student participants for the RRE will be selected based on their interest in environmental science, their willingness to learn, their maturity and ability to work well with other students and adults. Students will also be strongly encouraged to develop a year-long, monitoring or research project after they have attended the RRE, tapping their new-found skills as field researchers. Projects can be based on laboratory or field observations related to ecology and/or hydrology.

Equally important will be the goal of developing similar skills and interests in a research mentor for the student. These adults help us sustain this effort beyond the summer experience and assist the student during their subsequent research project. While it is highly recommended, it is not required that the mentor accompany the student to the Arizona Rives Training portion of the RRE, but they must be willing offer guidance and assistance during the following school year as the student engages in their research project.
