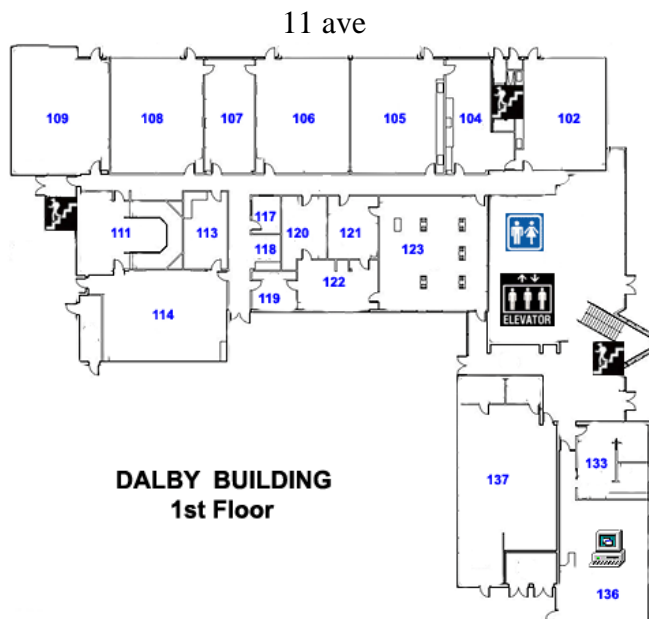

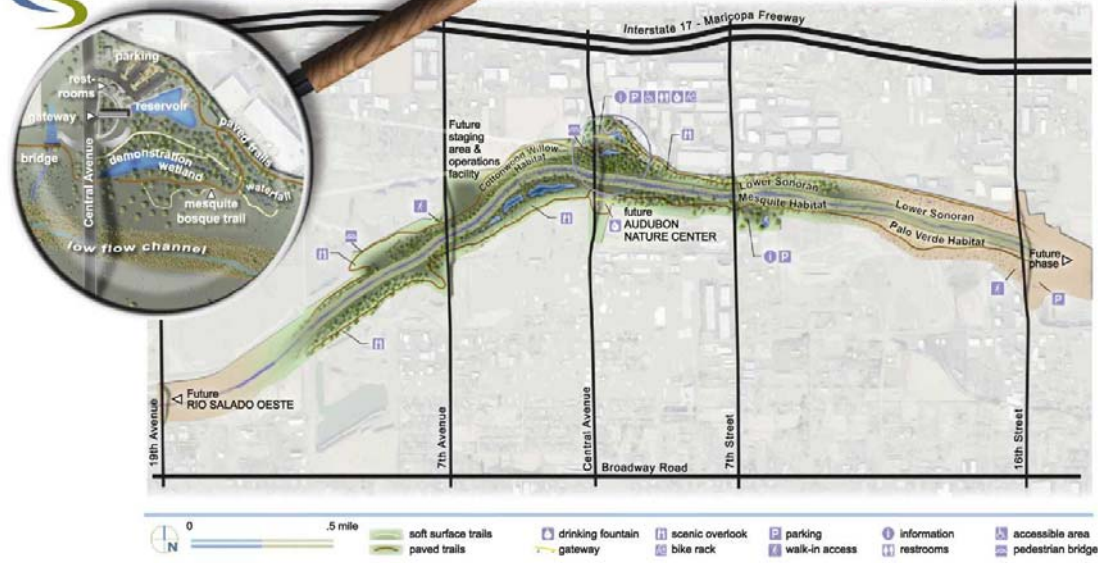
### Classroom:
